## **'CERTIFIED' OR EXPERIENCED??**

According to the most recent MLS statistics, short sales make up nearly 24 percent of home sales in the Sacramento region. Approximately 47 percent of the current listings on the market, however, are "short sale contingent," meaning a buyer has agreed to purchase the home but is still awaiting bank approval.

In layman's terms, almost half of all listings are short sales, but only a quarter of them are closing. Why is that? Could it be because banks aren't approving them, or does the short sale agent perhaps lack the experience to get that approval?

Oftentimes an agent will advertise that he or she is a "Certified" Short Sale Specialist — a title that's obtained by taking a 2-hour to 3-hour course from the California Association of Realtors. Taking a course to get certified, however, doesn't mean an agent has experience in listing, selling or closing a short sale.

Those considering short selling their home — or purchasing a short sale home — shouldn't assume that agents who are "certified" or say they're "specialists" actually have experience with short sales. So be sure to ask the right questions when choosing a Realtor in this arena: How many short sales have you closed? Which banks have you worked with? How quickly have you closed the short sales? Do you have any references?

Sacramento's Curtis Park is often considered one of the city's more well-to-do neighborhoods, and has been home to many of Sacramento's best known citizens, including Mayor Kevin Johnson. The neighborhood is roughly 1.3 square miles, and the majority of homes were built in 1939 or earlier.

The park itself has sometimes been called "Land Park without the zoo." It has a track; a playground; open space covered with grass for running around, playing soccer, or having a picnic; tennis and basketball courts; and many tall trees.

Earlier this year, a quarrel over 57 Heritage Trees on the Union Pacific Rail Yard site occurred between residents and a developer requesting to remove the trees, which have stood for more than 100 years. But earlier this year, it was determined that no heritage tree would be removed unless soil testing revealed contamination in excess of DTSC standards.
